**Do you sign up for the whole summer?**

**What are the age restrictions?**

Ages 10-14 (We have been known to bend age limits, on occasion.)

**What is the ratio of kids to teachers?**

Short answer : 7:1 We always have at least three adults with us, and our groups rarely exceed 20 kids, and when it does, we hire more staff.

**Where/when is the drop-off and pick-up?**

[Emmorton Rec Center at 2213 Old Emmorton Rd., Bel Air, MD 21015](#). We are there by 8:00 each morning to allow parents to drop-off early and get to work. Programming starts at 8:30. We return most days at 3:30. Rides home can be arranged for an extra fee.

**What are the qualifications of these teachers?**

Jim Pritchard is a Maryland certified teacher (since 1990) with many years of experience teaching science. He currently teaches at Southampton Middle School, HCPS. He's taught this program for over 20 years. He is certified in wilderness first aid and CPR.

Avery Pritchard is a MD certified teacher, who has been teaching at Stricker Middle in Baltimore County since Fall of 2013. She has been running **EcoTech Summer Camp** with her dad since 2007.
